

PEAR TREE PANAGORA EMERGING MARKETS FUND

FOR THE QUARTER ENDED JUNE 30, 2017 the Pear Tree PanAgora Emerging Markets Fund's* Ordinary Shares (the "Fund"), formerly known as the Pear Tree PanAgora Dynamic Emerging Markets Fund, underperformed its benchmark, the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (the "Index"). During the period, the Fund achieved a return of 3.14% at net asset value compared to 6.38% for the Index.

Market Conditions and Investment Strategies

On a country basis, the largest detractors were China (1.56%) and South Korea (0.49%). Among holdings in China, the largest detractor was not holding Tencent Holdings Ltd., while among holdings in South Korea, the largest detractor was an underweight position in Samsung Electronics. The largest contributors were Brazil 0.85% and Turkey 0.18%. Among holdings in Brazil, the largest contributor was not holding Petrobras, while among holdings in Turkey, the largest contributor was not holding Turkcell Iletisim Hizmet AS.

On a sector basis, the largest detractors were Information Technology (2.09%) and Telecom Services (0.40). Among holdings in Information Technology, the largest detractor was not holding Tencent Holdings Ltd., while among holdings in Telecom Services, the largest detractor was an overweight position in Mobile Telesystems. The largest contributors for the quarter were Health Care 0.46% and Energy 0.19%. Among holdings in Health Care, the largest contributor was an overweight position in Hanmi Science Co. Ltd., while among holdings in Energy, the largest contributor was not holding Petrobras.

Portfolio Changes

There were no significant portfolio changes during the quarter ending June 30, 2017.

Outlook
